2023 Russian River Valley Chardonnay

Russian River Valley, Sonoma County

Alcohol: 13.6%, pH: 3.30, T.A. 6.40gm/L

Blended from iconic sites like Rochioli, Allen, and Olivet Lane, our 2023 Russian River Valley Chardonnay captures the region's signature elegance and vibrant acidity. Hand-harvested grapes were gently pressed and fermented in 30% new French oak, aging on primary lees for 10 months to develop aromas of baked apple, golden pear, and citrus zest over a bright, silky palate of warm spice, brioche, and a crisp finish.

2023 Russian River Valley Pinot Noir

Russian River Valley, Sonoma County

Alcohol: 13.9%, pH: 3.40, T.A. 6.50gm/L

Sourced from renowned vineyards including Rochioli, Bacigalupi, and Hallberg, our 2023 Russian River Valley Pinot Noir showcases the region's signature richness and elegance. Hand-harvested, cold-soaked, gently pressed, and aged nine months in 35% new French oak. Aromas of red cherry and rose petals lead to a silky palate of ripe fruit, blood orange, and spice, framed by bright acidity and fine tannins.

2023 Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir

Sonoma Coast, Sonoma County

Alcohol: 13.6%, pH: 3.43, T.A. 6.80gm/L

Capturing the rugged beauty of the fog-shrouded coast, our 2023 Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir draws from Gap's Crown, Lancel Creek, Terra de Promissio, and Durell vineyards. A long, cool growing season produced concentrated fruit with exceptional structure and depth. Aromas of ocean spray, cranberry, and tart cherry mingle with clove and anise, leading to a silky palate of red and blue berries framed by bright acidity and fine tannins.

2023 Olivet Lane Vineyard Chardonnay

Russian River Valley, Sonoma County

Alcohol: 13.6%, pH: 3.18, T.A. 6.70gm/L

Olivet Lane Vineyard sits on 65 acres of sloping benchland in the Santa Rosa Plain, where cool fog, coastal breezes, and well-drained soils produce balanced Chardonnay with bright acidity. Hand-harvested grapes were whole-cluster pressed, fermented in 33% new French oak, and aged 10 months on lees. Fresh apricot, tangerine and lemon zest come together in a layered, expressive aromatic profile, accented by notes of unripe peach, honeysuckle, and a hint of pie crust. On the palate, creamy textures and citrus-driven flavors unfold with a sense of ease and lift.

2023 Hallberg Vineyard Pinot Noir

Russian River Valley, Sonoma County

Alcohol: 13.5%, pH: 3.39, T.A. 6.30gm/L

Hallberg Vineyard, in the Green Valley sub-appellation, benefits from cool marine breezes and steady temperatures that produce Pinot Noir with silky tannins, dark fruit, and earthy nuance. Hand-harvested fruit underwent partial whole-cluster fermentation, extended maceration, and 15 months of aging in 40% new French oak. Tart raspberry and red currant are accented by subtle herbaceous notes and delicate hints of white tea and soft oak add nuance without overshadowing the fruit-forward profile. On the palate, vibrant red berries take center stage, supported by a gentle savory undertone and a fine, dusty grip that adds texture and poise.
